Long or hoop earrings, necklaces or bracelets may not be worn during class. Cell phone use is not permitted during class; phones must be silenced and inside dance bags or backpacks during class.  Food items are not permitted in the dance studios. Water in closed containers is recommended.  Students are expected to arrive to class promptly. Students that arrive more than 15 minutes late, missing warm-up will be asked, for their own safety to observe class rather than participate.  Students should be picked up promptly after class. For safety, we ask that students not leave the lobby until their transportation has arrived. Please do not leave any children unattended except for those taking class. Remember, the dance studio is not a playroom. Siblings are welcome in the lobby under the supervision of an adult.  Students are expected to conduct themselves appropriately in class. Disruptiv or disrespectful students may be asked to sit out of class.  Attendance is vital to the continual growth and understanding of the material being covered in class. Excessive absences affect the individual as well as the other students. Students who miss more than 10 of any given class durin the current dance season and/or more than 3 classes after January 1st may not be adequately prepared to perform in the recital. Decisions regarding recital participation will be left up to the individual instructors.  Your child has been pre-approved for the most appropriate class, based on technique level, development, and growth, according to teachers' evaluations. Please respect the teachers' professional expertise, and only submit class change requests when there is an unavoidable time conflict. All requests to add/drop/change classes must be submitted to the office
